(Optional) Train Trip to beautiful Ely Cathedral

Ely Cathedral is located in the center of this historic city and is surrounded by mediaeval monastic buildings, parkland and meadows. A walk from the Cathedral through The Dean's Meadow and Cherry Hill Park will take you down to the riverside with its famous tearoom and restaurants. The surrounding gardens, lawns and parks make ideal spots for a picnic or somewhere to sit and enjoy the wonderful views. It is an optional tour together by train (approx. 20mins).
